MESSAGE

THE GOOD FAVOR

Scriptures:

Hosea 13:1-13

Psalms 90:17 & Isaiah 66:2

Genesis 1:1-2 & 1 Cor 2:7

1 Corinthians 3:10-14

Philippians 4:19

John 16:16-24



SUMMARY

This past weekend, we received a message called “The Good Favor” learning that God wants to pour out favor on His people so that we can accomplish all He wants to do in the earth as it is in Heaven.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Let's begin with defining favor - what is favor?
2. We mentioned that Psalm 90:17 let's us know to baptize our hands in God's purposes. What does that mean and how does it relate to favor?
3. What is the difference in a mindset of earning favor vs simply walking in to favor?
4. How would you define the 3 keys to favor found in Isaiah 66:2?
5. God has positioned us to light up the mystery we read about in Genesis 1:1-2 and 1 Corinthians 2:7. What is the mystery and how do we light it up?
6. What does favor have to do with mystery?
7. In Hosea 13, the people were walking in favor but then they walked out of favor. What caused the people to walk out of favor?
8. What can happen when you only “build” things with your hands instead of baptizing your hands in purpose?
9. We see in verse 3 a principle of things not built for the glory of God disappearing like the mist and blown away. What does this mean?

10. What does 1 Corinthians 3 mean when it talks about fire revealing the kind of work each builder has done?
11. What does the work we accomplish say about us?
12. God revealed the Savior even in Hosea 13 - how did the Savior exist before Jesus came in to the world and why is this important for us to understand?
13. When things go well people tend to forget about the “who” behind the “why” - God. Read Hosea 13:5 and talk about why this is an important reminder.
14. What is so “good” about Hosea 13:7-8?
15. What does favor have to do with God reminding us that He wants to be our one and only King and source we trust in and walk by?
16. Discuss the principle in Hosea 13:12-13 and John 16:16-24. What does it mean to either stay in the womb or be revealed?
17. Why is it good to remember that the pains of birthing is only for a moment?

CLOSING

Ask anyone for closing thoughts/questions and then ask someone to close in prayer - thank everyone for coming!
