A NEW SONG OF OIL & WINE

A Study of:
Song of Solomon 1:1-4



SUMMARY

This past weekend, we began a new teaching series, studying the Song of Solomon. Pastor Kyle talked about how although this is a book to be read literally as the dating and marriage story of a bride and groom, there is a revelation of how God wants His bride to pursue Him. The “new song” of our life is simply the way we cry out to God in our relationship with Him. Saturday, we talked about the New Song of Oil & Wine. Oil and Wine are symbols of that time representing joy, strength, healing and more and our new song is that God is better than anything this world can offer; that what we receive in our “oils and wines” is better and sufficient in Father God.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

*****the purpose of these questions is to facilitate a discussion, not to just get the answers - if only 1 person answers, keep going until there is a discussion around it. Pull it out of the people with things like “Come on, anyone else? Let’s Talk!”**

1. Is there anything that stood out to you in the message? Let’s start by sharing highlights of what you received from the teaching.
2. What does it mean to you, to sing a new song to the Lord?
3. We discussed the idea that God desires us to be His bride - let’s talk about walking as a bride He wants us to be according to Revelation 19:7-9. **4.** How would you define intimacy?
5. What does it mean for the bride of Christ to long for His kiss? How would you describe His kiss?
6. God wants us to draw near to Him, how do you draw near to God? Does anyone find it difficult?
7. Wine has the attributes of strength, joy, healing, and more - How is He better than wine? How does one’s life testify to this?
8. His name is described as the spreading of scented oils. What is it about the Name of God that shifts an atmosphere in such a way? How does calling on His name bring us close to Him?
9. Going in to the bedroom with God is a desire wanting to be “one” with Him. What does it mean to be “one” with God?
10. Any other thoughts about singing a new song in your life, that He is the best oil and wine there is?
