WELCOME & WORSHIP

MESSAGE

THE GOOD REMNANT

Scriptures:

Hosea 13:14-16

Hosea 14:1-9

2 Corinthians 3:18

Colossians 3:10

John 4:23-24



SUMMARY

This past weekend, we received a message called “The Good Remnant” learning that God calls us to repentance so that we can become the very image of God in the earth.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Is there anything that stood out to you in the message? Let’s start by sharing highlights of what you received from the teaching.
2. Let’s discuss the concept of God allowing “death and the grave” to reign over a people. What does this mean?
3. What is the key to walking in victory in your life rather than the oppression of “death and the grave”?
4. What does it mean to be the remnant of God?
5. How is it that in walking out redemption we are actually being revealed as the remnant?
6. In 2 Corinthians 3 and Colossians 3 we see that we are to look like God - How does a people begin to look like God?
7. The key to walking in His image is to repent. How do you define repentance?

8. Why is it important to understand that repentance can not just be a silent meditation in your heart according to Hosea 14:1-2?
9. Is there such thing as “rejected worship”? What is a worship that God does not receive look like?
10. John 4:23-24 tells us that worship must be represented in 2 things. What are these 2 things? Let’s define these in our life.
11. In Hosea 14:3, God wants the people to remember that they do not need more partnerships or systems to save them. What are examples of things we tend to lean on that can replace God?
12. How is a lack of faith likened to a disease that needs to be healed according to verse 4?
13. Can someone read Hosea 14:5-7? After reading - let’s all talk about what stands out to you and how this is the healing from the disease of a lack of faith.
14. God tells the people that He is like a tree that is always green and that all fruit comes from Him. What does this mean for us?
15. What does it mean to find identity in seasons vs identity in God?
16. How do we get the wisdom referred to in verse 9 in order to understand the things of God?

Ask anyone for closing thoughts/questions and then ask someone to close in prayer - thank everyone for coming!
