SERMON NOTES

1. Trusting in the lord to soar on wings like eagles is a picture of a people who have been healed and restored in the identity of Christ. Trusting meaning to bind together, and to soar on wings meaning to walk in a kingly authority. The imagery of flying gives us knowledge that the “air” or the spiritual realm, is ours, and not the one who operates in it called the “prince of the power of the air” who is Satan. Those that walk in this new nature no longer have to submit to a prince, because the prince has to submit to the king that he sees in you, because you are walking in the new nature, the likeness of God.
2. A new nature character we studied is that of tenderness. To be tender hearted is literally translated and likened to a bowel movement, a gut check feeling that moves one to compassion. There is an internal feeling that is quickly moved to compassion, not revenge, hate, or criticism. Putting on this nature is leaning to renew your mind every day so as not to let anything opposite of the fruit of His spirit to grow. People who do not have bowel movements develop a sickness - if we do not develop compassion out of a tender nature, we will become sick, full of hate, anger, bitterness, and more.
3. His camp is all around us and we have a responsibility as His people to make disciples that embrace a new nature to such a degree that we are moved to helping people drive out unclean things that do not belong in your clean, new nature. We are not to crucify people, rather deliver them in Jesus name.

DISCUSSION PROMPTS...

1. What spoke to you or stood out to you in the message?
2. Does anyone have anything they would like to talk about?
3. How do you put on a tender nature when you are not naturally tender? Is being naturally out of God's nature wrong?
4. How do you walk in a binded trust with God which gives way to walking in His authority?
5. How does tenderness help us develop the right way to bring correction with other believers and even the lost?
