

SERMON NOTES 5/16/26



God moved in this worship gathering in such a way that visions were shared, and a simple word from the scriptures reminds us to come and be satisfied at the table of God!

1. **Colossians 2:13-15** tells us that salvation is an invitation to union; with Christ.

It further tells us that our sinful nature has been cut away. You are completely free of it; life in Christ is about getting convinced of a new nature in Christ to such a degree that there is no more battle of a sin nature; you become unified with Christ in that desires change to your new natural in Christ.

2. **Colossians 2:16** encourages us to not be condemned for what we eat or drink, while **Psalms 23:5** tells us that there is a table to come and eat and drink of the Lord that satisfies us and fills us.

When we eat of His table, we have a new appetite for the things of God. We act differently, we respond differently, and it will not look like the world's normal. Do not let others condemn you for being different; let your different be the witness to Jesus!

The Table of God is full of things that you were originally created to eat and drink of; His ways, His nature, simply Him. He is what sustains us more than any pleasures of this world!

You will be condemned, the key is to not be moved by that condemnation!
